ABOUT PROGRAM

The training of students takes place at the clinical bases of 56 departments with a total number of staff of more than 500 people. The faculty trains medical specialists in the program of General Practitioner. A general practitioner is a broad medical specialist who has the skills of a narrow specialist.

After graduation from this program, a graduate can undergo postgraduate training as a general practitioner, or choose to train in narrow specialties, such as: therapist, surgeon, neuropathologist, obstetrician- gynecologist, traumatologist, otolaryngologist, oculist, oncologist and others.

The faculty trains foreign students who will become qualified specialists in the specialty of General Medicine in order to continue their professional activities abroad. Training of foreign students is conducted at 56 departments. The teaching staff is a highly qualified personnel, many of whom have extensive experience in teaching. Total 140 teachers work at the faculty, of which 10 are Doctors of Medical Science and 80 are Candidates of Medical sciences, 9 Professors and 39 Associate Professors. Currently, more than 3,744 foreign students from 26 countries, such as, India, Nepal, Jordan, Somalia, Turkey, Palestine, the USA, Germany, Egypt, South Korea, study at the Faculty. A separate student campus named after Prof. I.Akylbekov was set up and equipped for foreign students. The campus is located in a landscape place called Tash-Dobo near the Bishkek.

FEE PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment Schedule

- Tuition fees and Hostel-Mess fees must be paid in advance, as per the schedule specified by University
- Prior to the commencement of each semester, students are required to settle all tuition and semester fees. Failure to make payment will result in the student being ineligible to proceed to the next semester.
- Hostel stay is compulsory for 1st and second year and must be paid before arriving in the destination country.
- Students opting for financial loan services shall ensure the process is completed prior to their travel confirmation.

Late Payment & Penalties:

- Failure to meet payment deadlines may result in late payment penalties or additional charges.
- Upon obtaining a visa and officially commencing classes, students will be charged for one semester's fee.

Refund Policy:

- Refunds for tuition fees and other charges are subject to the university's refund policy. Refunds will be calculated based on the services availed by the student.

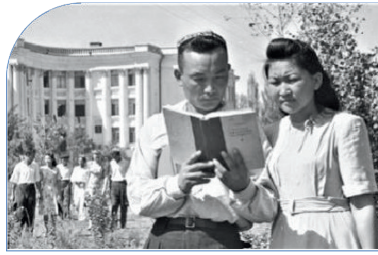


HELLO FROM KYRGYZSTAN

CAMPUS & DEPARTMENTS

Centers of knowledge, Science & Research

Center for Clinical Skills Development and Knowledge Assessment

The Center was established in 2013 with the financial and technical support of the Swiss Embassy in Kyrgyzstan. At the Center, students, residents and interns are trained in clinical skills on simulators and dummies. Also, students pass their testings (computer testing and OSCE), entrance, transfer and final exams.



Intersectoral Educational and Scientific Center for Biomedical Research

It is a research and educational center of the KSMA and the Laboratory of Screening and Molecular Modeling of Biologically Active Compounds (BAC) of the National Academy of Sciences. The Center integrates university and academic science; combine the efforts of scientific and logistical potential to develop fundamental problems of biology and medicine. It has three labs: PCR, biochemical and pathomorphology.



Educational, medical and scientific Medical Center

It is the scientific, clinical and educational base of KSMU. The medical center provides the population with a wide range of medical services, including surgical operations, diagnostics of internal organs and dentistry.



Diagnostic Medical Center

This is the educational, scientific and clinical base of the university. Today, the center provides diagnostic services: ultrasound; REG; Gastroscopy; colonoscopy; X-ray examination. Also, represents the services of an optometrist, ENT, gastroenterologist, dermatologist, endocrinologist, physiotherapist.



Dental Educational, Scientific and Clinical Center

It is an educational and scientific clinical base for professional training of students of the Faculty of Dentistry and postgraduate training of dentists (interns, clinical residents, postgraduates)



Center for Distance Learning and Advanced Training

The Center implements distance learning for clinical residents of KSMA undergoing residency in the regions of the Kyrgyz Republic. Also, provides technical facilities for teachers and other medical institutions to master additional skills through training in advanced training programs; to conduct online seminars, video conferences and webinars.



Pre-University Training Center

The center's activities are aimed at intensive training of lyceum students and students in the following subjects: chemistry, biology, mathematics, Russian and Kyrgyz languages for the subsequent successful passing of the national ORT test. It has in its structure a Lyceum (grades 10-11) and a department of pre-university training for foreign citizens with English as the language of instruction.



Foreign Language Learning Center

The Center was established in 2016 with the support of the European TEMPUS program within the framework of the project "FLEPP: Teaching foreign languages for professional purposes". Currently, the Center provides training in English, German and Turkish languages for students and teachers of KSMU and all other interested persons.
